Philippians 3:18-21

Paul's broken to the point of tears because of what he has to say to

It's no different than a parent properly disciplining a child they love

- It's painful to discipline
- That's why it's called "tough love."

If it isn't going to hurt you to offer the discipline that you're not the right person to do it

Godly discipline always hurts both parties at the moment

Philippians 3:18-19 For, as I have often told you before and now tell you again even with tears, many live as enemies of the cross of Christ. <sup>19</sup>Their destiny is destruction

These enemies can best be understood as people claiming to follow Christ but at the same time corrupting His message and insulting His reputation by immoral lifestyles and false teachings.

Paul takes a very hard stand against this compromised living, and so SHOULD WE

Philippians 3:19 Their destiny is destruction, <u>their god is their stomach</u>, and their glory is in their shame. Their mind is set on earthly things.

There are two camps here:

- 1. There are the "legalists"
  - · Works gain spiritual life
- 2. They are the "libertines"
  - Grace covers open and repeated sins
